

# CPESEN<sup>®</sup> USA Quality Assurance Data Collection and Transmission

The Quality Assurance Data Collection and Transmission Standard creates a single standard for the availability of data to support quality assurance across all local CPESN networks and pharmacies participating in CPESN USA and supports clinical integration requirements. Restrictions regarding use of pharmacy data by CPESN USA are described in Section A.2.a of your CPESN USA Participation Agreement. This standard can be revised only by action of the Board of Managers. Local CPESN networks always have the prerogative to require different or additional data transmission or clinical documentation standards for their network.

## Current Standards for Quality Assurance Data Collection and Transmission:

1. As functionality becomes available through HIT vendors in use in pharmacies participating in CPESN USA, initiate regular transmission of fill history to CPESN USA for quality assurance purposes.
2. Initiate monthly transmission of eCare Plans to CPESN USA for quality assurance purposes. Pharmacies that joined CPESN USA prior to 7/1/2018 are required to begin transmitting care plans by 1/1/2019. Pharmacies that join CPESN USA on 7/1/2018 or after are required to begin transmitting eCare Plans within 6 months of the effective date on their CPESN USA participation agreement.
